The 1906 Lodge opened in May of 2009 after several years of renovation. It has 17 rooms and suites, all uniquely decorated to honor a person or place from Coronado's past. Summer rates start at \$199 and include complimentary gourmet breakfast, afternoon wine and cheese, underground parking, evening turndown, loaner beach chairs and lots of personal attention from the innkeepers.

Unusual in a small hotel, the 1906 Lodge has several conference rooms. They are ideal for meetings up to 40 attendees. Catered meals in the dining room or in the garden courtyard make it easy to combine work with socializing. The Lodge is also a great venue for wedding parties and retreats.
